Hyva makes use of cookie technology to distinguish you from other users of our website. What is a cookie?

Cookies are small files stored on your computer or mobile device. Cookies contain (click) information that which is sent back to the web server each time the user or browser performs a request. This enables your computer/device to recognise past settings and past visits. There are two main kinds of cookies: session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are deleted from your computer/device when you close your browser, whereas persistent cookies remain stored on your computer/device until deleted, or until they reach their expiry date.

Cookie usage on our website

HYVA only uses analytical cookies, which allow us to identify and count the number of website visitors and to see their browsing behaviour around the website. These cookies enable us to improve our website, for instance by ensuring that users are finding the information they require.

Hyva uses Google Analytics cookies. Google Analytics generates statistical and other information about website use by means of cookies, which are stored on the user's computer/device. The information generated relating to our website is used to create reports about the use of the website. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to our website, where visitors have come to the website from and the pages they visited.
